I had lots of plans back in 2020 but then Covid shut us down right after St Paddy's Day. Still, in the past two years we have had more music and more German Music than any two years previously.

From a wedding feast in 2020 with about 200 attendees to a full Oktoberfest this year, that was the Fourth Best Oktoberrfest in club history, it was a magnificent year. In 2020 I took over the planning for Christkindlmarkt with over 30 vendors and this year we set a record with over 50 vendor booths sold and a record gross profit of over \$40,000.

Even with the shut down the board and I accomplished much, and I will be leaving office on December 31st with about \$200,000 in the bank, which is about \$140,000 better than when I took office. Joe Pettyjohn brought back great outside catering events and much needed income. Rolf, Mike, and Ralph transformed the entrance into a warm German like "Stube" with natural wood and ambiance of the old country. Closets, the basement and the outside were cleaned out and the club took on a new look without all the clutter.

With the election over, Jon Linton, our new president and I have had some great discussions before and after the election regarding the next phase of our club's history. I do wish him well and God speed in taking the club forward. From our discussions I know he and the new board will do their best for the future of our club. I will be around to help and support Jon in his every plan. Please get behind him and volunteer your time to make the club better.

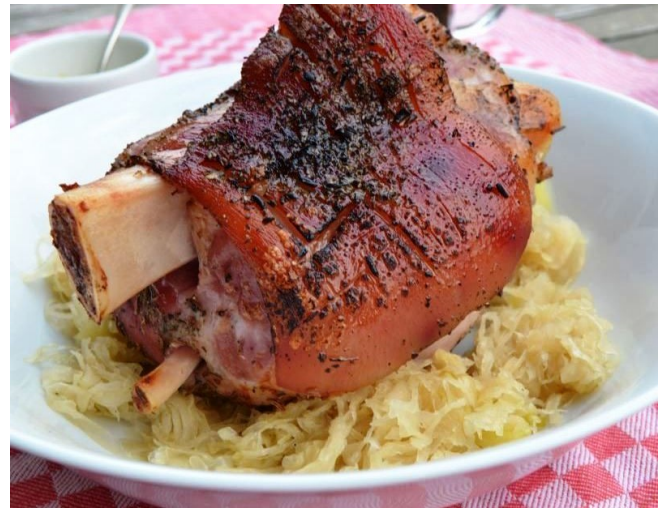

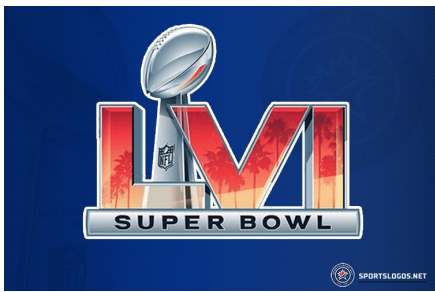
