Reading Liederkranz 2023 annual membership dues will remain **§25.00 per member per year**. Payment of annual dues for the upcoming year will be accepted starting September 1, 2022 and are to be **paid by December 31, 2022**. Members whose dues are not paid by December 31, 2022 shall receive a notice via email from the Financial Secretary by January 15, 2023. To remain an active member, annual dues must be paid before **February 1, 2023**. Any member that chooses to renew between **February 1, 2023 and March 31, 2023** will incur an additional **§10.00 late renewal fee**. All members not current with their dues by March 31, 2023 will be **dropped** from the paper and electronic mailing lists, and are **required to reapply for membership, losing all accrued years**. Members needing a **new card**, regardless if it is lost or damaged will be assessed **§15.00** per card to cover costs.

We thank all of our members or promptly renewing their membership. You may renew your membership at any time at the club, by mail, or electronically by filling out a **Renewal Slip**. Please see an officer to receive a renewal slip. Members can also mail in their renewal dues with the **Renewal Slip** below.
