120 years ago, Eagle Mt. Home was formed and bought the land that the Reading Lieder-kranz now owns. Throughout most of the years, they have had an active group of people using the facility. In the 30's and 40's there was a swimming pond, picnic area, and a large number of members brought their families up for Saturday and Sunday on the mountain. In the 50's, the building was renovated with an addition on the kitchen side. The building was heated for the first time, and we really became a year-round facility. In the 60's and 70's through the 80's, the membership declined but the club was still active. In 1989 the Reading Liederkranz became active members of the EMH and helped them continue their success. Since 1990 the Liederkranz has taken ownership of the building and has continued improving and actively using the facility and its grounds.





COVID AND CDC UPDATE FROM MARK GOTTHELF, 2ND VP

Dear Fellow Members,

As we begin to see some progress in emerging from our pandemic, we must remain diligent. I am including the latest CDC Guidelines specific to those receiving vaccines. Please continue to be safe. Thank you,

Pennsylvania has eased its mask mandate to allow people who are fully vaccinated against COVID-19 to gather with other vaccinated people without masks or social distancing, state health officials said.

The <u>new rules</u> also apply to vaccinated people gathering with people from a single household who have not been vaccinated but who are considered at low risk of severe disease from the coronavirus — such as vaccinated grandparents visiting with healthy grandchildren.

Vaccinated people also no longer have to quarantine following an exposure to someone with COVID-19, as long as they do not develop symptoms, state health officials said.

Acting Secretary of Health Alison Beam revised the state's existing masking order to align with <u>recent guidance</u> from the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.


