

# Reading Liederkranz Weekly Drawing Rules & Regulations

All proceeds benefit the Ladies Auxiliary and are used to purchase needed items for the club. The Ladies thank you!








# CHRISTKINDLMARKT INFORMATION If you are a vendor and would like information, call Heidi at 610-955-3030


