

Reading Liederkranz 2024 Membership Renewal

Reading Liederkranz 2024 annual membership dues will remain **\$25.00 per member per year**. Payment of annual dues for the upcoming year will be accepted starting September 1, 2023 and are to be **paid by December 31, 2023** Members whose dues are not paid by December 31, 2023 shall receive a notice via email from the Financial Secretary by January 15, 2024. To remain an active member, annual dues must be paid before **February 1, 2024**. Any member that chooses to renew between **February 1, 2024 and March 31, 2024** will incur an additional **\$10.00 late renewal fee**. All members not current with their dues by March 31, 2024 will be **dropped** from the paper and electronic mailing lists, and are **required to reapply for membership, losing all accrued years**. Members needing a **new card**, regardless if it is lost or damaged will be assessed **\$15.00** per card to cover costs.

Please see an officer to receive a renewal slip. Members can also mail in their renewal dues with the **Renewal Slip** below. 
