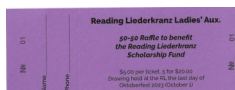


**EAGLES'

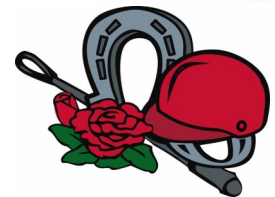
